Denis Brkić was born in Osijek, Croatia, on February 15, 1968. He completed his primary and secondary education in Valpovo, Croatia, and his undergraduate studies in Croatian Language and Literature at the Faculty of Education at the University of Josip Juraj Strossmayer in Osijek. After graduating from university, he received his teaching certificate in Croatian Language and Literature. He worked for the first six months at the Valpovo Secondary School, and in September 1993, he joined the Daruvar Secondary School, which was later renamed the Daruvar Economic and Tourism School. He has been working there ever since, completing thirty years of active service. He is a volunteer of the Croatian War of Independence and a recipient of the Homeland War Memorial.

During his career, he has participated in many cultural and artistic programs within the framework of the "Lidrano" school competitions. He also collaborates directly with the City of Daruvar, leading the Daruvar Amateur Theater, writing plays, and engaging in amateur acting and directing.
