

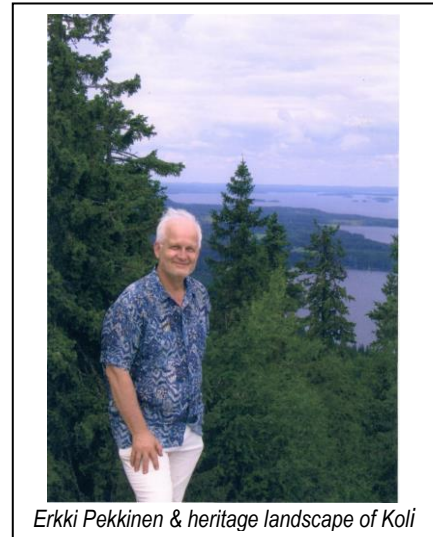

Principal subjects/occupational skills covered	I hold the competence of sworn/official/authorized translator and I have served as interpreter at several depositions involving the mobile telecommunications industry. Depositions in 2017 (4 days, June), in 2011 (Feb 9-11), in 2010 (June 1, 7, 17, 30), 2009 (Sept. 9), and 2008 (Jan 22, 29) held in Helsinki and Salo, Tampere, and Oulu (in Finland), in Oslo (Norway), and in London (England) under contract to four different agencies. I have also translated (FI-EN and EN-FI) several patent texts (in the fields of construction, mobile phone technology, and mechanical engineering) as well as proofread patent texts translated by other translators. Moreover, I have gained experience in automotive translations, legal terminology, international public law, criminal law and contract law ; and I have acquired technical terminology in the following fields: budget and finance, human resources, information and communications technology, security, facility management, general services, events organization, various sciences (forest research, laser scanning, zoology, botany, geology, life sciences (incl. numerous medical reports, descriptions of pharmaceuticals)) . Have also delivered English-to-Finnish translations in the automotive field (GM) via an agency in Sweden, this lasted for approx. 1 year earlier in the current decade.
